brooklyn college summer program in london

Application Instructions

Admission to the Brooklyn College Summer Program in London is by application. The program is open to any student with a GPA of 3.0 or above who is in good standing at his or her home university at the time of application. Admission decisions will be made on a rolling basis with completed applications processed in the order in which they are received. Please follow the instructions below carefully.

- 1. All students must complete and sign a two-page "Brooklyn College Study Abroad Student Application" and return it to the address at the bottom left of this page.
- 2. Students from schools other than Brooklyn College must arrange to have an official transcript sent to the address at the bottom left of this page. An application will not be considered complete until the transcript is received.
- 3. All students must submit a one-page statement of purpose. This statement should demonstrate how this program is related to your present academic program or goals. The statement should also describe the personal benefits you expect to receive from participation in the program. Please feel free to include any additional information that may be useful in evaluating your candidacy. An application will not be considered complete without the statement of purpose.
- 4. All applications must include a \$500 deposit in the form of a check or money order made payable to: Brooklyn College Member Organization. In the memo field, please write: Summer Program in London 05. An application will not be considered complete without payment of deposit. This deposit is non-refundable. If a student is not admitted into the program after application, a \$75 application fee will be deducted and the balance (\$425) returned. For students accepted into the program, the full \$500 deposit will be applied towards the program fees. Students accepted into the program, who withdraw before paying the balance of their program fees or prior to departure, are not entitled to a refund of this deposit. The balance of the program fees is due in two installments: \$1,725 due 21 March and \$1,725 due 09 May 2007. Failure to meet this payment schedule may result in the student being dropped from the program. Once a student is accepted into the program, all fees paid are non-refundable.
- 5. In certain instances, an applicant may be required to arrange an in-person or phone interview with the program director.

Applicants should expect a decision on admission within three weeks of receipt of the completed application.
