

JURADO, KATY (1927– 2002)

Born María Cristina Estella Marcel Jurado García in Guadalajara, Mexico, on January 16, 1927, the actress, Katy Jurado is best known for her stellar role in *High Noon* (1952). She began an acclaimed career in both Mexican and U.S. films at the age of sixteen. In addition to *High Noon*, for which she received a Best Supporting Actress Golden Globe, Jurado was nominated for a Best Supporting Actress Academy Award for *Broken Lance*, (1954), and won a Silver Ariel for her film *Fe, esperanza, y caridad* (1973). In 1998 Jurado won a Best Supporting Actress Silver Ariel for *Evangelio de las maravillas* (1998).
