Students must complete Health and Nutrition Sciences 747X and 791.1X and must complete 12 additional credits approved by the Department advisor.

Education 722.11 – Advanced Seminar in Pedagogy and Curriculum (3)

Education 724.11 – Seminar in Educational Research (3) – Must be taken AFTER 722.11
and AFTER at least 15 of the required 18 credits in Phys Ed are completed
